LIFE DRAWING with Chuck Gilliam

This life drawing class will help you come to an understanding of how you can draw the human figure. We will begin with recognizing the various components that make up the human figure. From there we will build on this basic structure and learn to draw the human figure in any pose we want. We will continue this process and learn how to clothe the figure. The class will focus on all of this the first day. On the second day, we will have live models posing in various positions and in various costumes to allow the artists to develop their skills in drawing the human figure.

You will need a sketchbook or paper and various drawing instruments such as pencils and erasers. You may also bring colored pencils and/or colored pastels if you wish, especially on the second day.
