- Red: Primary Magenta, Quinacridone Red or Alizarin Crimson, or Cadmium Red Light
- Yellow: Primary Yellow, Diarylide Yellow, Yellow Ochre
- Blue: Primary Cyan, Ultramarine Blue, Phthalocyanine Blue
- Orange: Pyrrole Orange or Cadmium Orange
- Green: Permanent Green
- Violet: Dioxazine Purple
- Brown: Raw Umber, Burnt Sienna
